



National Collegiate Landscape Competition - Exhibitor Code of Conduct

Failure to comply with any of these rules will result in removal from the National Collegiate Landscape Competition.

1. Exhibitors are required to comply with all laws, including any employment laws pertaining to the interviewing and hiring of students on site at NCLC.
2. All exhibitors are expected to demonstrate courteous and respectful behavior toward other exhibitors, attendees, staff, vendors and partners of NCLC.
3. Hosting outside activities that conflict with official NCLC activities is strictly prohibited.
4. Subletting, selling or renting a portion of yours or another exhibitor's booth is strictly prohibited.
5. No exhibitor may allow another individual to represent a different company under their exhibitor registration. All exhibitor personnel must be employed by the exhibitor.
6. All Exhibitors and company representatives must be registered and wear official NALP National Collegiate Landscape Competition badges at all times on the NCLC show floor. Badges may not be shared. Sharing of an official badge will result in all parties being removed from the show floor.
7. Exhibitors must comply with the official show hours, including set-up and tear-down hours. This includes having their booth completely set up by the time the show begins and having it completely torn down and removed by the time tear-down hours end (including removing all trash). Exhibitors must have their booth staffed by at least one person during show hours.
8. Sharing opinions regarding any other exhibiting company with career fair students is strictly prohibited.
9. Exhibitor placements are made by the NALP staff. Exhibitors may not trade or transfer booth placements.
10. All exhibitor signage and materials must be confined to the exhibitor booth space allotted by show management.
