Why:

*The continuing resolution which is temporarily funding the government is set to expire on November 21<sup>st</sup> and right now we have nothing more than 66,000 H-2B visas for FY20. We have an opportunity to push positive H-2B language in FY20 spending measures that would save seasonal businesses that desperately need workers. BUT time is of the essence and we need to put the pressure on our elected officials to support the H-2B program while critical funding measures are negotiated to keep the government open and funded through 2020.*
